\_\_\_\_\_ **ALLIED ARTS:** A character portrayal, or a story through action, with whistling as part of the enactment. Examples are: mime, acting, singing, instrumentation, improvisation, comedy, dance, and unique vocal sounds such as hand-whistling and bird calls). Separate Championships are named for Allied Arts.
